The national curriculum for languages aims to ensure that all pupils:

understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources

- speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussion and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation
- can write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt
- discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studied.

NB: due to covid lockdowns, roll-out of ilanguages program has been delayed and, therefore, all year groups started on Year 3 program in September 2021.

CTK MFL Intent, Implementation and Impact

<u>Intent</u>

Our emphasis is upon building an engaging knowledge and vocabulary-rich curriculum, which progressively builds upon key vocabulary and grammar used in the French language. Students will build an understanding of use of masculine/feminine vocabulary and some basic verb conjugation.

Implementation

Planning will be broadly based upon the ilanguages program which aims to broaden/teach French vocabulary and also introduces students to culture and conventions of French society. Students will learn through songs, stories and poems, strengthened by repetition of vocabulary from previous lessons.

<u>Impact</u>

Constant repetition of vocabulary, rhymes, stories, etc will help children to remember and retain vocabulary and grammar.
