

Comprehension.

When we read, it is important that we have understood what we have read. We check that we have understood it by answering questions about what we have read. At Christ the King, we follow VIPERS when thinking about the different types of question we might come across.



Each week we're going to read a bit more of the same book and try to answer different types of questions. You will see a letter next to the question number and this is to show you what reading skill you are using by answering the question.

- 2) V Why did the author write the words 'holding their breath...' to describe how the socks were waiting every morning.
- 3) R Where do the woolly socks go?
- 4) I How do you think Simon is feeling when he says "Oh, I didn't realise I was odd," Give you reasons.
- 5) S What is the problem in the story?
- 6) E Do you think Simon has got good reasons for not wanting to be odd?
- 7) P What do you think will happen next?
